

ČSR was reestablished. A new system in society among democracy and totalitarianism was referred to as "People's democracy".



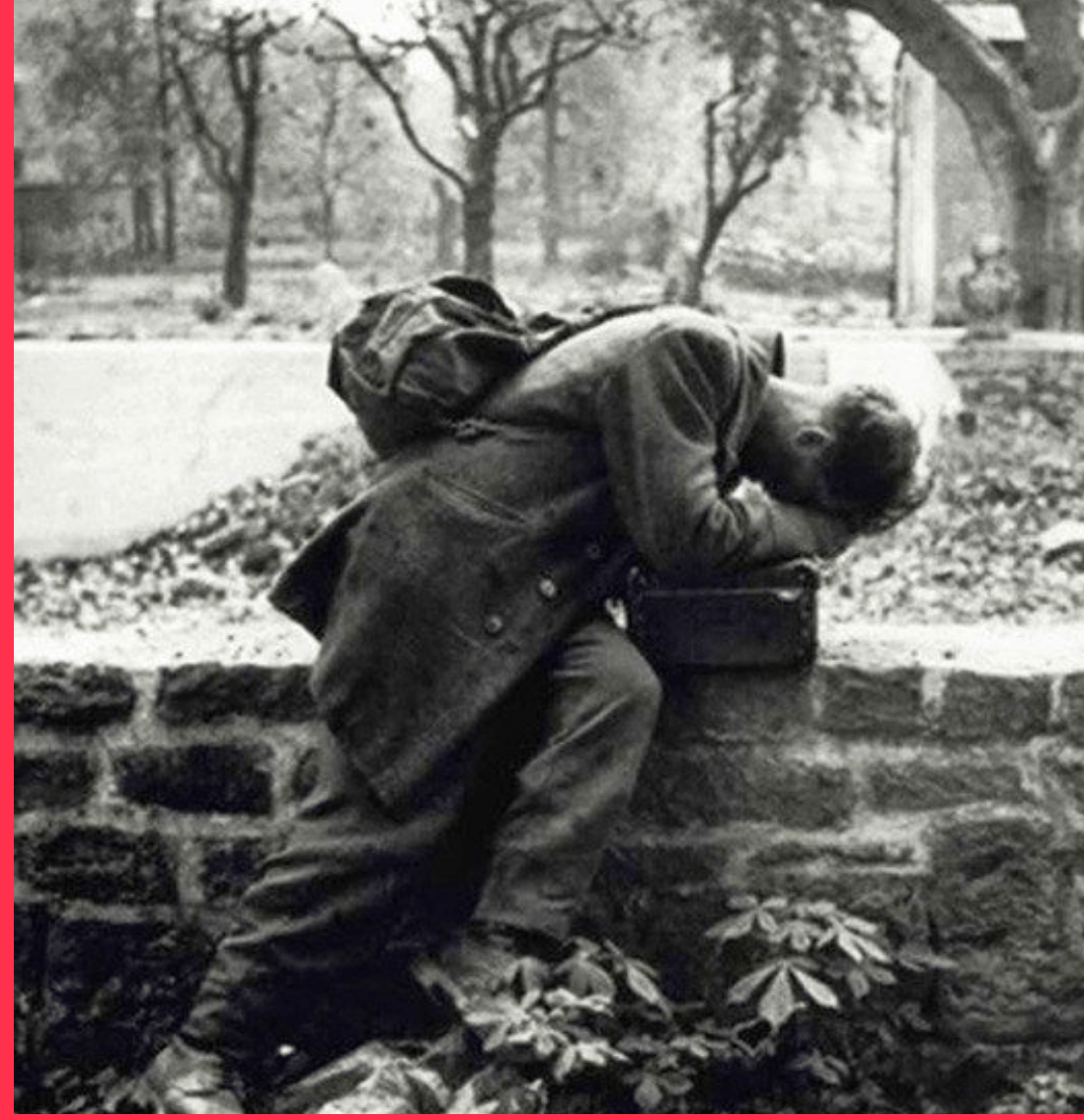
